Mid-Amateur Championship	144	36 holes of stroke play with gross and net age divisions: (25-34, 35-44, 45 & Over).	KGA member golfers that turn 25 years old by May 3, 2010.	
Public Links Championship	120	36 holes of stroke play with gross and net age group (30 & Under, 31 to 49, 50 & Over)	KGA members whose golf facility does not limit its access to members and their guests. Cart included as part of entry fee.	
Junior Amateur Championship	192	54 holes stroke play with age group competitions. A cut will be made after 36 holes to the low 15 scores or all players within 10 strokes of the leader of each age division.	KGA male member golfers that are not older than 18 on June 15, 2010, or recently graduated from high school. Practice round included on June 14.	
Kansas Amateur	TBD	Monday, July 19	Practice Round	KGA member golfers that have a USGA handicap index of 12.5 or less.

Exempt players must pay the full \$200 entry fee at the time of entry submission.
		Thursday, July 22	1 st round of match play	Last Chance Qualifier: Players that fail to qualify or miss the initial entry deadline date may attempt to qualify again by entering the Last Chance Qualifier to be held on July 7. An additional \$80 entry fee is required to enter the Last Chance Qualifier, which will be credited to towards the \$200 championship entry fee if the player qualifies.

High Plains Amateur	144	36 holes of stroke play with three divisions available: Open – 34 & Under, Masters – 35 to 49, Senior – 50 & Over.	Open to all amateur golfers regardless of club or state affiliation.	

REFUNDS: The KGA's policy is no refunds except for sickness or extenuating circumstances. To withdraw, please notify the KGA office immediately.

- If a player properly withdraws prior to the close of entries, upon proper written request, the player will receive a full refund of the entry fee, less a \$20 administrative fee.
- If a player properly withdraws after the entries close and more than 48 hours prior to the start of the event, upon proper written request, the player will receive a refund of 50% of the entry fee.
- NO REFUND will be made to a player that withdraws less than 48 hours prior to the start of the event.

ENTRY PRIORITY STATUS: Any player that entered the championship each of the preceding two years (2008 and 2009) shall have an entry priority over other earlier entrants that did not enter the event in both of those prior years. This entry priority will be given to eligible entrants from February 1 to March 1 only.
