Four-Ball Championship	TBA	OPEN: 36 holes of stroke play qualifying for 32-team Four-Ball match play bracket. Open to all ages. 36 hole final match..	Open to any amateur golfer, including non-members. KGA members have priority until March 1, 2010 at which time non-KGA member teams will be accepted.
	TBA	MASTERS: 36 holes of stroke play qualifying for 16-team Four-Ball match play bracket. Must be at least 40 years old. 18 hole final match.	Entire championship is held on Alvarado Golf Course.
Junior Team Championship	96	1 st round: Four-Ball Stroke Play 2 nd round: Foursome Alternate Shot	Open to all golfers that are not older than 18 on June 28, 2010 or recently graduated from high school with a KGA or KJGA membership.
Father and Son	96	36 holes of four-ball stroke play with gross and net competition. Two divisions available (Open and Junior Division). Cart and lunch included for both rounds of championship.	Open to male amateur golfers. One team member must be a KGA member, and both players must have a USGA handicap. Grandfather/grandson and step-father/step-son teams may participate. Minimum age is 14 years old.
Senior Team Championship	96	1 st round: Two-man Shamble 2 nd round: Modified Chapman Alternate Shot 3 rd round: Four-Ball Stroke Play Three divisions available: Championship Gross, Net, Super Senior Division (both players age 65 & over).	Any KGA member that turns 50 years old by September 27, 2010 and has a USGA handicap. Top 20 gross teams from the 2009 championship have a reserved spot in the field provided the deadline is met.
Mid-Am Team	96	1 st round: Two-man Shamble. 2 nd round: Modified Chapman Alternate Shot. 3 rd round: Four-Ball Stroke Play. Cart provided as part of entry fee. Lunch provided for first two rounds of championship.	Any KGA member that turns 25 years old by October 4, 2010 and has a USGA handicap. The team must have a combined Handicap Index of 16 or less. Top 20 teams from the 2009 championship have a reserved spot in the field provided the deadline is met.

REFUNDS: The KGA's policy is no refunds except for sickness or extenuating circumstances. To withdraw, please notify the KGA office immediately.

- If a player properly withdraws prior to the close of entries, upon proper written request, the player will receive a full refund of the entry fee, less a \$20 administrative fee.
- If a player properly withdraws after the entries close and more than 48 hours prior to the start of the event, upon proper written request, the player will receive a refund of 50% of the entry fee.
- NO REFUND will be made to a player that withdraws less than 48 hours prior to the start of the event.

ENTRY PRIORITY STATUS: Any team (team members must be the same) that entered the championship each of the preceding two years (2008 and 2009) shall have an entry priority over other earlier entrants that did not enter the event in both of those prior years. This entry priority will be given to eligible entrants from February 1 to March 1 only.
