The Scholarship is renewable for four years, and must be used for expenses at an accredited college or university in Kansas, including community colleges.

## Required Supporting Information

Applicant must submit the following information to the Kansas Golf Foundation. All submissions become the property of KGF.

1. Completed KJG Scholarship Application (KGF form)
2. Proof of acceptance to college
3. High school transcript
4. Information showing applicant's participation in high school golf or junior golf activities.
5. Two letters of recommendation: from a teacher or administrator from the applicant's high school alma mater, and from a person (unrelated to applicant) who knows the applicant as a result of the applicant's involvement with golf.
6. Financial information: A copy of the applicant's Student Aid Report (SAR) from FAFSA. If the SAR has not been received, the applicant must submit a copy of completed Sections 3 and 4 of the applicant's FAFSA worksheet. ***NOTE: the application will not be considered if the above financial information is not submitted. If the SAR is not available, applicant must provide completed FAFSA Sections 3 and 4.***
7. A copy of the applicant's SAT or ACT Score Reports
8. An essay (no longer than 2 pages) about (a) why the applicant deserves the KJG Scholarship, (b) how the applicant has benefitted from the game of golf, and (c) the applicant's educational and career goals.

## Selection Criteria

Applications for the Kansas Junior Golf Scholarship are reviewed by the Foundation's Junior Golf Scholarship committee. Junior Golf Scholars are selected based on the applicant's academic record, character, essay, financial need, leadership and community service, letters of recommendation, and participation in golf.
