# Greetings Kansas Junior Golfers

From 2010 KGA President Jack Simpson

Welcome to the 25<sup>th</sup> year of the KJGA. This program is designed to offer competitive golf for juniors across the state of Kansas.

For a nominal membership and entry fee, a junior golfer under the age of 19 or recently graduated from high school and not yet enrolled in college, will be eligible to compete and earn qualifying points in four tournaments in their section of Kansas. Members also receive a KJGA bag tag and a quick reference guide to the most commonly applied Rules of Golf.

## Players please note:

- A player whose section is full and has met the entry deadline may compete in another section's events. The player may compete for medals, junior cup points, and will be ELIGIBLE to compete for that section team.
- Female Golfers will be allowed to play with the boys in their section of residence or participate in a "Girls Division" in the Northeast, North Central and West Sections. (New for 2010)
- The deadline for entry is MAY 14, 2010, at 4:00 p.m. All entries must be RECEIVED by that time.
- Cargo shorts or pants will not be allowed in any KGA or KJGA sponsored event.

KJGA players will have the opportunity to earn points toward representing their section in the KJGA Junior Section Team Championship and the Junior Match Play Championship for the top 16 players in the state. The top eight junior golfers based on the points list will comprise the 2010 Kansas Junior Cup Team. This team will compete against their Nebraska counterparts on August 8-10, 2010, at Prairie Dunes Country Club, Hutchinson, KS. The junior cup point list will also be used to determine the 2010 KGA Junior Player of the Year and the invitees for the 11<sup>th</sup> Collegiate Preview Series.

# KJGA Rules and Regulations

## Eligibility

1. Open to junior golfers who have not reached their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday by June 1, 2010 (or have recently graduated from high school). Your age on June 1, 2010 determines the age group of competition for the entire summer program. Also, if you have attended a college or junior college, you are not eligible to participate. **Example:** If you turn 16 on May 20, 2010, you compete in the 16-17 age group; if you turn 18 on July 1, 2010, you compete in all events in the 16-17 age group.

**Note:** The KGA Junior Amateur Championship, June 14-17, 2010, at Crestview Country Club, Pittsburg, has different age eligibility requirements (18 or younger as of June 15<sup>th</sup> or recently graduated from high school). Also, if you have attended a college or junior college, you are NOT eligible.

2. **All KJGA members age 14 years or older as of June 1, 2010, must have an active USGA/GHIN handicap index number.**
3. There is no minimum age requirement.
4. There is no minimum handicap requirement; however, *since this is a competitive golf program*, entrants should possess the ability to complete 18 holes in four hours or less and score under 100 strokes for an 18-hole round (60 or less for 9-holes, 11 & under age group).
5. The tournament field at each section event will be limited to 120 players with the following reserved numbers for each age division. Entries will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. The following is a distribution of each age division's reserved spots. The other 40 spots will be filled as demand requires.

# Membership Dues & Entry Fees

1. Membership in the KJGA is \$25.00 per year and is paid with a completed application. Membership is required to participate in the KJGA program. KJGA membership is available at anytime throughout the season. ***ENTRY FEES will NOT be accepted without the proper entry application.***
2. **Each** KJGA Section Tournament entry fee is \$35.00. Each of the sections will offer four tournaments. **EXAMPLE:** If you enter only one tournament, the total fee is \$60.00. If you choose to enter all four tournaments, the total fee is \$165.00 (There is an additional \$5 credit card fee).
3. In order to participate in any tournament in your section, the KGA office **MUST** receive your entry form and fee by **4:00 p.m., May 14, 2010. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED!** KGA Staff will NOT be responsible for the delivery of money orders or any other form of payment for the program fee. This is strictly the responsibility of the entrant.
4. **PLEASE NOTE:** Players may compete in events (up to FOUR) outside of their section but only if the desired event in their section is FULL and they meet entry deadline criteria. Players playing outside of their section may win medals, earn Junior Cup Points, and are eligible for that section's junior team. We strongly encourage entering the West and/or Southeast section events due to more availability. **ONLY SELECT ALTERNATE TOURNAMENTS THAT YOU ARE WILLING TO GO TO!!** If you are placed in an alternate tournament that you have selected and have a conflict, no refund will be issued!
5. NO green fees are paid to the golf course by the player on the day of the event.
6. Practice rounds will be at the discretion of the host facility.

## Entry Forms

1. Pre-registration is **REQUIRED**. ALL players must submit their entry form to the Kansas Golf Association office at 1201 Wakarusa Drive, Suite B5, Lawrence, Kansas 66049 or enter online at [www.kansasgolf.org](http://www.kansasgolf.org).
  - Entries received prior to March 1, 2010, will be returned.
  - **DO NOT SEND ENTRIES TO YOUR SECTION CHAIRPERSON.**

- Entries must be received by May 14<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 p.m. Entries received after this deadline will not be accepted. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Postmark date does not apply.
- 2. The entry form must be completed in full and signed by player and parent/guardian. Incomplete entry forms will be returned.
- 3. All entry forms must indicate which of the four section events the player would like to enter and the correct entry and membership fee must be included.
- 4. If at the time of entry a junior golfer can not be placed in events of the section of residence, he may select another section for entry. The junior golfer making such a selection must play within that section throughout the 2010 program. He will be able to win medals, earn section team and junior cup points and play in the Junior Section Team Championship for that section. We strongly encourage entering West and Southeast section events due to availability.

## Refunds

PLEASE NOTE: Entry fees will only be refunded if the section event entered becomes full. After the deadline, **NO REFUNDS** will be offered for any reason. **There are NO refunds for events that have been cancelled due to weather.**

## Tee Times

1. Player information and starting times are posted on the KGA website 5 days prior to the event. They are not mailed. If you do not have Internet access, call your section chairperson or the KGA office.
2. **DO NOT BE LATE FOR YOUR TEE TIME.** It is the player's responsibility to show up on time; there is no call to the tee. Arriving within five minutes after your published starting time will result in a two-stroke penalty. After five minutes you will be **disqualified**.
3. Do not ask for a change in your assigned tee time. If you have a special request, state it with your entry form, and your Section Chairperson will be notified and attempt to meet the request.

# Caddies, Carts, & Equipment

1. All players must walk and carry their own clubs. Non-motorized pull carts are allowed.
2. Parents and friends may **NOT** caddy or put clubs on a cart.  
*Penalty: DISQUALIFICATION*
3. Players must have their own clubs (No sharing with another player)
4. Golf shoes are recommended, but not required. As a condition of competition, the KJGA players will **NOT** be allowed to wear the traditional steel or ceramic tipped spikes on their golf shoes. Players may wear golf shoes with alternative “spikeless” products, i.e. “Soft Spikes.” Players may also wear any golf-teaching shoe, tennis shoe, sneaker, or any other hard or soft-soled shoe that will not penetrate and/or damage a soft putting green.

*Penalty: DISQUALIFICATION.*

**Note:** The KJGA and the Kansas Golf Association assumes no liability to players for this condition of the competition (no-spikes). By submitting the program entry form and subsequently playing in the events, player agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the KJGA, KGA and its respective affiliates, directors, officers, employees, agents and assigns from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities and losses, including without limitation reasonable attorney’s fees, costs, and expenses of litigation, arising out of any negligent act or omission of the indemnifying party in connection with the wearing of “spikeless” shoes.

5. Proper golf attire is **ABSOLUTELY REQUIRED**. **NO** t-shirts, tank tops, cargo shorts or denim shorts (whether cut-off or hemmed). **NO BLUE JEANS**. **NO CARGO PANTS**. Your shirt **MUST** be tucked in and have a collar. **If worn, hats MUST have the bill forward**. If you do not meet the dress code, you will **NOT** be permitted to play.

# Competition

1. Five Age Divisions: 11 & Under (9 Holes), 12-13, 14-15, 16-17 and 18 are the age divisions. ALL age divisions from age 12-18 will play 18 holes. The 11 & Under age division along with the 12-13 age division will play from the forward tees. Girls Divisions are located only in the Northeast, North Central, and West Sections. All girls will pay the red/forward tees.
2. Awards: Medals to the top three in each age division for each of the four section events. A scorecard playoff will decide ties for medals; however, the points will be split evenly. Scorecard playoff will begin on the #1 playoff hole.
3. The field at each of the section events will be limited to 120 players and distributed throughout the age divisions. Please see the “limitation of players” section for more information.
4. Players that finish in the top four of their age division (top 3 in 11 & Under and 18 divisions) for the four tournaments based on “section points” earned will qualify to represent their section in the Junior Section Team Championship, July 26-28, 2010, at Eagle Bend Golf Course in Lawrence, Kansas.
5. ALL decisions made by the KGA and KJGA are FINAL!
7. Ties for positions on the section teams are broken as follows:
  - A. If all players are present at the final section event site, a sudden death playoff will be used.
  - B. If not all are present—The player who has the highest single finish in any one of the section events will be selected.
  - C. If still tied—The player who has placed higher in head-to-head competition. If they both have finished above the other and are still tied, go to the next highest finish.
  - D. The player who has competed in the most section events in 2010.
  - E. If tie still exists the spot will be determined by lot.

## Withdrawals & Returning Scorecards

If a player begins any competition and fails to return a scorecard, or **if they enter a competition and do not play without notifying the Section Chairperson in advance of the competition**, that player will be penalized two strokes at the start of play in the next KJGA event they enter. Repeated violations could result in suspension from KJGA and KGA sponsored events.

## No Shows

It is the player's responsibility to appear, prior to his assigned starting time. Tee times are posted to the KGA website several days in advance of the competition. If, for whatever reason, a player is unable to compete in a particular event, it is the player's responsibility to notify the Section Chairman, either by email or phone, at least 24 hours prior to the event. Contact information for all section chairmen is located within this booklet. Failure to do so constitutes a "no show" and the player will be assessed a two stroke penalty at the next event in which they compete. Repeat violations will result in suspension from all future KJGA and KGA competitions. Exceptions to this policy will be dealt with on a case by case basis only.

## Spectators

The host club may allow parents or other friends to rent carts. Spectators are always welcome at events but are **NOT** allowed to give advice or assistance (club selection, rulings, etc.). Spectators are asked to help spot golf balls. However; they should not hold a conversation when in search of a golf ball. Spectators shall **NEVER** pick up **ANY** golf ball from the golf course. In general, spectators are asked to remain 20 yards from ALL competitors. Violations of parent/spectator etiquette could result in a **DISQUALIFICATION** of a junior competitor. Spectators should view from the side of the hole rather than directly behind the players, so as to not disturb the group following. Thank you for your interest.

# Code of Conduct

1. **All players are expected to conduct themselves in a courteous manner. NO profanity, throwing/slamming clubs, or other inappropriate behavior.** *See Code of Conduct on inside back cover for more details.*
2. Any contestant that is found to be cheating will be **DISQUALIFIED**, and suspended for the remainder of the year from all KJGA and KGA events.

## Section Event Point System

The following point system **ONLY** applies to qualifying for the Section Team Championship. These points are earned at the four junior section events conducted in each of the six sections of the State. The section event points **DO NOT** apply to Junior Cup Points.

### WITHIN YOUR AGE DIVISION

First	6 points
Second	4 points
Third	3 points
Fourth	2 points
Fifth	1 point

Note: These points are awarded at each Junior Section event. In the case of ties, points are divided evenly. Medals are awarded based on a scorecard play-off procedure (no additional holes are played). The top 3 players in each age division will comprise a 15-member team from each section. The five section teams will compete in the KJGA Junior Section Team Championship, July 26-28, 2010, at Eagle Bend Golf Course, Lawrence, Kansas.

## THE KANSAS-NEBRASKA JUNIOR CUP MATCHES

Every summer the Kansas Junior Golf Association selects a team of eight junior golfers to compete against their counterparts from Nebraska. In order to compete on the Kansas Team, a junior golfer must be a member of the KJGA. Then, throughout the summer the junior golfer may compete for junior cup points at various junior tournaments at the local, state and national levels. At the conclusion of the season (following the KGA Junior Match Play Championship), the top eight point earners are invited to represent Kansas against Nebraska.

In 1986, Alvamar Country Club (Lawrence) hosted the first cup matches. Nebraska won the first meeting by collecting 10 points to Kansas' 6 points. The matches are played like the Ryder Cup Matches. Team members are first paired for four-ball matches the first morning of competition. Then in the afternoon, they will again be paired for foursome matches. The second day consists of singles matches in the morning and the trophy presentation following lunch in the afternoon. Each match is worth one point. The team with the most points takes control of the traveling trophy for the upcoming year. Through the twenty four years of competition, the series is now tied 12-12. The 2010 KS-NE Cup will be held at Prairie Dunes Country Club, Hutchinson, KS August 8-10, 2010.

## **THE OZARK JUNIOR CHALLENGE**

In order to compete on the Kansas Team, a junior golfer must be a member of the KJGA. Then, throughout the summer, the junior golfer may compete for junior cup points at various tournaments at the local, state and national levels. At the conclusion of the season (following the KGA Junior Match Play Championship) the top five point earners are invited to represent Kansas against the other two states.

The Inaugural Ozark Junior Challenge was conducted in 1996 at Twin Hills Country Club in Joplin, Missouri. The team of golfers from Oklahoma prevailed. The “college” format is the basis for team scoring. All players play stroke-play and the team drops one score for each round to determine the team total. In 2010 the Junior Ozark Challenge will not be held.

- 2010 Ozark Junior Challenge Team Members (AR, MO, KS)
- 2010 Kansas-Nebraska Cup Team Members

Top 30 players on the Nebraska, Iowa, Missouri, Oklahoma, Arkansas, and Kansas Junior Cup Point List on August 1, 2010. **Other players may submit entry on a first come basis, and must be granted entry by the Collegiate Preview Series Committee.**

Additionally, CPS players have the opportunity to earn points toward the All Collegiate Preview Series Team. Points will be awarded at each tournament with the top six players being recognized at the final CPS event. Each team member will then receive a certificate of recognition. Note the points awarded for collegiate preview series events will go toward junior player of the year points for the following year.

# **Kansas Junior Golf Association (KJGA)**

## **CODE OF CONDUCT & DRESS CODE**

***COMPETITORS MUST FOLLOW THE RULES ON THE GOLF COURSE AT ALL TIMES. PROPER CONDUCT IS A MUST!***

1. Know and play by the Rules of Golf as set by the USGA.
2. Use decent language. No profanity.
3. Respect and care for the property of others.
4. Respect the golf course (replace divots, repair greens, rake bunkers and use the proper containers for trash).
5. Wear proper golf attire (collared shirt, slacks or Bermuda-length shorts) **NO denim or cargo shorts** (whether cut-off or hemmed), NO cargo pants, NO jeans, NO tee shirts, NO tank tops! Mock turtleneck style shirts are acceptable.
6. Spectators and families of junior golfers are also expected to follow the KJGA dress code.

***COMPETITORS NEED TO KNOW THAT THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT ALLOWED OR ACCEPTED ON OR OFF THE GOLF COURSE AT ANY KGA EVENT***

1. **IMPROPER ATTIRE**-Tennis shorts, **cargo shorts**, cargo pants, T-shirts, tank tops, jeans, cut-offs, sweats.
2. **ELECTRONIC DEVICES**-The use of **mobile phones**, noise-making pagers, radios, Walkman and/or similar noise making devices is NOT permitted! Penalty-Disqualification.
3. **IMPROPER ETIQUETTE**-Damaging greens, defacing or destroying club property, littering, leaving divots or ball marks, failure to rake bunkers, etc.
4. **UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT**-Cheating, violations of the Rules of Golf, swearing, obscene, vulgar, or abusive language, throwing clubs, displaying poor behavior or conduct unbecoming.

**Failure to comply with any of the above guidelines could result in your automatic removal from the competition. The KGA and KJGA enforce a zero tolerance policy in regards to the above guidelines. No warning or probation will be extended for any violation. Repeat violations of the above guidelines will result in a permanent ban from all KGA and KJGA events.**
