## **KANSAS JUNIOR GOLF SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM**

Application Deadline: April 2, 2012

The Kansas Golf Foundation awards academic scholarships to five deserving Kansas Junior Golfers, both men and women, through the Kansas Junior Golf Scholarship. Applicants must have participated in high school golf or in junior golf activities. The Scholarship is renewable for four years, and must be used for expenses at an accredited college or university in Kansas, including community colleges. Junior Golf Scholars are selected based on the applicant's academic record, essay, financial need, leadership and community service, letters of recommendation, and participation in golf.

### **Required Supporting Information**

Applicant must submit all of the following information to the Kansas Golf Foundation by the deadline. All submissions become the property of KGF.

1. Completed KJG Scholarship Application form.
2. Essay (2 pages or less) on how the applicant has benefitted from the game of golf and how golf has influenced the applicant's educational and career goals.
3. High school transcript, including applicant's SAT or ACT Score Reports.
4. Verification of applicant's participation in high school golf or junior golf.
5. Financial information: A copy of the applicant's Student Aid Report (SAR) from FAFSA. ***If the SAR is not available, applicant must provide completed Sections 3 and 4 from the FAFSA worksheet.***
6. Statement of applicant's community service and leadership experiences and accomplishments.
7. Two letters of recommendation: from a teacher or administrator from the applicant's high school alma mater, and from a person (unrelated to applicant) who knows the applicant as a result of the applicant's involvement with golf.
