

## KANSAS JUNIOR GOLF SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

Application Deadline: March 30, 2018

The Kansas Golf Foundation awards academic scholarships to five deserving Kansas Junior Golfers, both men and women, through the Kansas Junior Golf Scholarship. Applicants must have participated in high school golf or in junior golf activities. The Scholarship is \$1,500 per year, renewable for four years, and must be used for expenses at an accredited college or university in Kansas, including community colleges. Junior Golf Scholars are selected based on the applicant's academic record, essay, financial need, leadership and community service, letters of recommendation, and participation in golf.

### Required Supporting Information

Applicant must submit all of the following information to the Kansas Golf Foundation by the deadline. **Submission electronically (PDF) is strongly encouraged.**

1. Completed KJG Scholarship Application form.
2. Essay (2 pages or less) on how golf has influenced the applicant and his/her career goals.
3. High school transcript, including applicant's SAT or ACT Scores.
4. Verification of applicant's participation in high school golf or junior golf.
5. Financial information: A copy of the applicant's Student Aid Report (SAR) from FAFSA. If the SAR is not available, applicant must provide completed Sections 3 and 4 from the FAFSA worksheet.
6. Statement of applicant's community service, leadership experiences and

- accomplishments.
7. Two letters of recommendation: from a teacher or administrator from the applicant's high school, and from a person (unrelated to applicant) who knows the applicant as a result of the applicant's involvement with golf.
